### **ELIGIBILITY**

Candidates must be registered for a doctorate at a British or overseas university, or have completed a doctorate within two years of the application deadline. Candidates must not hold a full-time academic position at the time of award.

## **STIPENDS**

The Scholarship will cover attendance fees for the Symposium, accommodation and subsistence (including attendance at the conference dinner). Scholarships do not include travel to or from Harlaxton Manor.

### **DEADLINES AND APPLICATION FORMAT**

Complete applications must be received by the Harlaxton Secretary no later than the 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. Applicants must arrange for a supporting letter of reference to be sent separately to arrive no later than the 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. References should be provided by the candidate's doctoral supervisor. If this is not possible an explanation should be provided on the application form.
